


Goderich Beach Clean-up A Success!

We are thrilled to announce that **175** volunteers came out to our Goderich clean-up in celebration of Earth Day! We had great community turnout from volunteers of all ages who persevered through some unexpected (not so nice) weather to make that happen. Below are a few pictures to help encapsulate the day.




22 million pounds of plastic pollution end up in the Great Lakes every year. Hosting beach clean-ups lessens local risk to wildlife through entanglement and ingestion while improving water quality and the aesthetic value of our lake.

Our volunteers removed **480 pounds** of litter from the Lake Huron shoreline. Cigarette butts were by far the most collected item at 77%, followed by plastic pieces at 9%, Styrofoam and food wrappers at 5% and beverage cans at 4%.

Our charitable conservation programs provide communities with free and unique opportunities to connect with nature for the betterment of Lake Huron. These programs beach clean-ups that **directly** include improves the health of beaches and wildlife.
